

**Sunday 8 AM in-person** worship resumes on September 20th. It will be **in the courtyard** weather permitting. These guidelines following the Center for Disease Control have been agreed upon by the Worship and Music Committee, the COVID Re-opening Task Force and St. Andrew's Congregational Council:

- All worshippers for 8 AM will **enter the building from the main entrance at the narthex** and proceed towards the ramp to the Fellowship Hall and directly out to the courtyard. (Those who require wheelchair accessibility may enter through the double doors between the kitchen and the pre-school entrance.)
- Please **BRING YOUR OWN CHAIR** to sit in the courtyard!
- We will observe **physical distancing of at least 6 feet**. However, families and households ("units") that have been together regularly in the past months may be seated together. Please contact the church office with who is in your unit.
- **Masks are required, covering both nose and mouth**. We wear face-coverings to fulfill our Lord's command to love our neighbors as ourselves. Should you forget your mask, they will be available at the entrance.
- **Outside 8 AM worshippers MAY SING gently** with their facial covering on.
- **If the weather is bad we will worship in the Fellowship Hall** with masks and social distance.
- All worshippers must **sign-in on the sheets on the cart by the doors to the courtyard**, so that, if an infection occurs, we will be able to track attendance accurately.
- **Hand sanitizing stations** are available in the narthex.
- **Service bulletins will be with the sign-in sheet** on the cart.
- Those who gather in-person for 8 AM worship are **not allowed in any other areas of the church** except the narthex. **To attend the Augsburg Bible Study in the Augsburg Room and the Adult Discussion Class in the Fireplace Room at 9:15 AM** worshippers will exit the way they came. The Adult Discussion Class will also be available via Zoom.
